Guest Speakers: Steve Medina, from the Red Cross, presented information on the Sound The Alarm program which provides free inspection and replacement of non working smoke detectors, which are not hard wired, with ten year lithium battery smoke detectors. A sign up sheet was circulated during the meeting.

Residents who did not sign up during the meeting, and are interested in having their smoke detectors inspected, should contact Carla Thompson 805-320-0992 to be added to the sign up sheet.

Because this service is provided by Red Cross volunteers at no charge, it will be after the first of the year before a date can be determined to do the smoke detector inspections/replacements.

Old Business: Carla Thompson drove to Camarillo and personally dropped off the Red Cross donation from HOB.

New Business: There is a new recycle bin in the enclosure in front of where the old bins were kept. This new bin has two holes on top to drop the bottles and cans; this new bin will help prevent theft of our recycle items; about \$100/month in recycle items were being stolen from the old bins.
